410. THOMAS ROACH CASE (Mamre) was born 28 Dec. 1808 in Simsbury and died 29 Sept. 1884 in Simsbury. (23 Nov., cemetery record.) He married 10 Sept. 1834 in the Simsbury First Church ELIZABETH GILLETTE, daughter of James and Violet (Case) Gillette. She died 4 Sept. 1840 at the age of 25. (Church record.) He married (2) 5 Oct. 1841 in Hartford(VR) (he was of Troy, N.Y. at time of this marriage) AMELIA ABIGAIL OLMSTED, daughter of Lynde and Amelia Olmsted, who died 22 Oct. 1842 at the age of 23. He married (3) CORNELIA E. TROWBRIDGE who was born 10 May 1824 in New York and died 26 Aug. 1900. Thomas, Elizabeth and Cornelia are buried in the Hopmeadow Cemetery in Simsbury. Amelia is buried in the Center Cemetery in East Hartford.
